

Online and Blended Learning





Education Programmes for Young People in Thurrock with an EHCP

Thurrock Adult Community College offers full-time study programmes tailored to the needs and personal goals of individual young people who have an Education Health and Care Plan so they can learn, grow in confidence, increase independence and develop skills for further study and employment. Integral to the classroom-based experience, learners will participate in a wide variety of enrichment activities including outdoor education.

Managing the Transition to Adulthood (MTA) for 16-24 year olds with an EHCP

For people with learning disabilities and difficulties, the transition from school to adulthood and greater independence is often a challenging one. The MTA programmes aim to develop the personal, social and life skills required by young adults in Thurrock moving towards further study, working and volunteering and/or independent living.


Be Inspired! For 18-24 year olds with an EHCP

This programme provides extra support for 18-24 year olds to plan and manage the next steps into higher education or employment and to develop the higher-level skills to get there. Aimed at young people who have already completed a Level 2 or 3 qualification, this is a full-time one year programme tailored to meet each young person's needs and aspirations.


