These courses are for you whether you are getting back into work, not sure what sector you want to work in, are employed and looking for promotion or just for personal development.


Many courses are FREE, including level 3 courses if it is your first full level 3 aualification.

FREE COURSES: **ENGLISH & MATHS**



If you are interested and want to join a class please call <u>01375 372476</u> to book an appointment to come to college to meet our teachers for an initial assessment. Alternatively you can book online.

Whether you struggle with reading and writing or are ready to study at GCSE level, we have a course that will enable you to achieve your goals.

English and Maths are essential skills to get into work - more and more employers are looking for job applicants with English and Maths qualifications achieved within the last 3 years. Most university and higher education colleges require you to have at least a level 2 or GCSE qualification to study there.

Even if you're not looking for work or higher education, these courses will boost your confidence or help you to support your children with their school work.

Part time courses start throughout the year. Some are face to face in college, some online or a mix of both. Start and end times are school friendly to enable you to drop off or pick up children. Evening classes are available.

Will there be an exam?

Most of our courses include an assessment which takes place in the classroom when you and your tutor feel you are ready. You will have plenty of time to prepare and practice, supported by your tutor.

GCSEs have fixed exam dates and these are set by the government.

You will receive a nationally recognised qualification usually Functional Skills - and a certificate.

WHAT WILL I LEARN?



You will practise all four skills during your course at the level most appropriate for you:

- Reading straightforward texts encountered in everyday life and work
- Writing straightforward texts aimed at a variety of audiences; showing good grasp of spelling, punctuation and grammar
- Listening to others; understanding and responding to them



Maths

The key aim is to enable you to gain confidence in mathematics. You will practise a number of aspects, including: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division; percentages; fractions; calculating the area and volume; ratio and algebra.



Creative Writing

This course will introduce you to the wonderful world of creative writing!

It will empower you to use your existing writing skills to express yourself, experiment with a variety of genres, and unlock your imagination.

So much of our daily and working life relies on us being able to use computers and live and work online.

This was really evident during the past year or so when we met friends and family on Zoom, did online shopping, completed online forms to consult your doctor etc. The world of work, like everything else, has changed as a result of the pandemic - online meetings, online diaries and collaborative work spaces online.

Would you like to brush up your skills, boost your confidence, upskill yourself ready for a career change, further study or maximise your chances of getting back into work?

Essential Digital Skills will give you the confidence and skills to live, work and learn in the new

digital world and achieve a nationally recognised qualification to put on your CV or job application form.

Do you need to improve your English?

Thurrock Adult Community College offers ESOL classes to help you develop your English and get a qualification.

DIGITA

FREE COURSES

You will improve reading, writing, speaking, listening, grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation. This will help you with things like: talking to your neighbours, supporting your children with homework, going shopping, getting a job or going onto another course. You will also learn about different aspects of living and working in the UK.

The classes are usually twice a week, normally for a total of 6 hours. They are at different times of the day: mornings, afternoon and evenings to enable you to work and/or do the school runs.

Before you start, you will do an initial skills check to ensure you join the most suitable class. Beginners who do not speak, read or write English are welcome! Courses are free if you are unemployed or earn less than £17,374 each year.



Wellbeing

In recent years, a sense of community and wellbeing have never been so important to us and our families and friends. Lockdowns and restrictions due to the Pandemic have affected us all in different ways. Many courses could be free under the Level 2 and Level 3 entitlements and for some learners on ESOL and vocational qualification courses if they; receive certain state benefits (eg. JSA/ESA/UC), meet specific funding criteria or are on a low income (evidence required). A discretionary learner support fund (DLSF) is also available for all learners (criteria applies) for courses up to and including Level 2 (or Level 3 for the National Skills Fund), to help with course fees and related costs, including childcare fees, travel and equipment loans.

While studying, there may be times when you need a little extra support. We understand this and our class tutors work together with our Learner Support and Guidance Team to make all reasonable adjustments that will help you achieve your individual goals.
