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Cost of living - how can we help?

We offer many free courses. English, maths and digital skills courses are free for everyone. English for speakers of other languages (ESOL) and vocational qualification courses may be free for learners receiving some benefits or on a low income. A Discretionary Learner Support Fund (DLSF) is also available for those in financial hardship for courses up to and including Level 2, to help with course fees and related costs, including childcare fees, travel and equipment loans. Some level 3 courses may also be free, if you do not already have a level 3 qualification, or already have a level 3 qualification or higher but earn below the National Living Wage annually, or already have a level 3 qualification or higher but are unemployed.

If you are currently out of work and in receipt of universal credit, courses are free and we can help you update your CV and finding a new job.

Help with childcare costs

With some of our courses we may be able to help you with the cost of childcare whilst you are attending your course. These are normally courses that lead to a qualification. Maximum payment is £20 per session and the childcare provider must be Ofsted registered. Support to achieve

We aim to help you succeed, and to enhance your experience and development. We understand there may be times when you need a little extra support to reach your goal. Our class tutors work together with our Learner Support and Guidance Team to make all reasonable adjustments that will help you achieve your individual goals. If you have a disability, learning difficulty or long-term health condition, please let us know before the start of your course, on the enrolment form.

Skills scan

Some of our courses lead to qualifications. To be able to enrol on these courses you will need to come into college to meet the tutors and have a skills scan.

This is so you are enrolled on the right level course for you. The skills scan will take approximately one and a half hours. We do not allow children at these sessions.

When you come to your appointment please bring:

One document from the following list

- Passport (UK or Irish only)
- ARC, Biometric Residence permit (BRP), Home Office Letter, Pre-settled or Settled documentation from Home Office or Government share code

AND another document from the following list

- Driving Licence (full or provisional)
- Council Tax Bill 23/24
- Bank statement or utility bill (dated within last three months)

If you earn below £20,319 per year, please bring your last three months' payslips – as you may qualify for a free course or reduced fees.

If you have arrived from Ukraine, you must provide all of the following documents;

- Home Office Letter
- Passport (both pages with picture and official stamp)
- Residency Permit (if you have got one)

Appointments can either be face-to-face or virtually via Microsoft Teams.

We offer English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL), English, and maths courses at all levels in a relaxed and supportive adult learning environment. Our aim is to help you gain confidence as well as qualifications and help you to get on a route to achieve your goals.

All our courses are part time and run over a duration of up to 17 weeks. Courses start in September or February, but you can enrol at any time throughout the year. The start and end times are school friendly enabling you to drop off or pick up children and evening classes are available.

You can also study around your shifts at work because we offer the same course several times per week.

Before starting your course, you will need to attend a skills scan to ensure you are joining the right course for you prior qualifications will be taken into consideration where relevant.

ENGLISH

All English courses are free (subject to eligibility).

Whether your goal is learning to read, improving your writing skills, or working towards a functional skills or GCSE qualification our experienced tutors will work with you to identify the things you need to focus on and support you in achieving your goals.

We place everyone in a class with others of similar abilities, so if you are just starting learning to read, do not feel worried, your classmates will be in a similar position and all abilities are welcome.

GCSE English

Our GCSE course is an essential qualification for anyone who would like to develop their higher-order reading skills and effective writing. You will work towards a GCSE in English Language (9-1). It is one of the most commonly required qualifications by employers and universities and will enhance your job and education prospects.

GCSE English is free if you meet the residency requirements and you have not achieved a grade C or above previously. Grade 4 is equivalent to a C.

Creative Writing

This course will introduce you to the wonderful world of creative writing. It will empower you to use your existing writing skills to express yourself, experiment with a variety of genres, and unlock your imagination.

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MULTIPLY

Multiply is a Government initiative which started in September 2022 designed to help people across England to improve their maths skills.



Thurrock Council will receive over £1 million over the next three years to support this work. Thurrock Adult Community College is leading on this project and will be developing activities to engage people across Thurrock.

Employers can benefit from boosting their workforce's maths skills by working with the college to design bespoke programmes for their workforce – at no cost to them. In some cases, a financial incentive will be available.

People with higher level maths skills are more likely to be in employment, have higher wages and enjoy better wellbeing.

There will be a range of free activities, events, workshops and short courses to help Thurrock residents and their families to:

- increase wages
- deal with the rising cost of living
- support children with their schoolwork
- improve wellbeing
- give access to higher level qualifications or apprenticeships
- progress in their careers

MATHS

All maths (including GCSE) courses are free (subject to eligibility). Maths is an essential skill in everyday life and can open the door to a range of careers.

You will focus on using maths to solve problems found in everyday life as well as in the workplace. You will practise several topics, including addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, percentages, fractions, calculating the area and volume, ratio and algebra. You will develop independent learning skills and confidence using maths in a range of contexts.

GCSE Maths

Gaining a GCSE maths qualification is essential for many career pathways. Our year long course will provide you with the materials and resources to work towards achieving the

ENGLISH FOR SPEAKERS OF OTHER LANGUAGES (ESOL)

If English is not your first language, you can join our class - English for Speakers of Other Languages - ESOL.

We will help you improve your reading, writing, speaking, listening, grammar, vocabulary, and pronunciation. Our aim is to help you with things like talking to your neighbours, supporting your children with homework, going shopping, getting a job, or progressing onto another course. You will also learn about various aspects of living and working in the UK.

The classes are usually twice a week, for a total of six hours. They vary in times of the day: mornings, afternoons, and evenings are all available to enable you to work and/or do the school runs.

Before you start, you will need to attend a skills scan to ensure you are joining the best class for you. Beginners who do not speak, read, or write English are welcome.

Courses are free if you are unemployed or earn less than £20,319 each year (Subject to change April 2024).

ASSOCIATION OF ACCOUNTING TECHNICIANS (AAT)-BOOKKEEPING

Whether you are already working in business or finance, taking your first steps or have your own business, these courses will offer further training in several accounting and bookkeeping activities.

Our courses build from basic to higher levels and cover the skills and knowledge you need to start your career in finance and accounting. These include developing practical accountancy skills, checking transactions for accuracy, using accounting software, producing reports and much more. The qualifications are awarded by the Association of Accounting Technicians which is the UK's leading body for accounting staff.

COUNSELLING

Having the right combination of skills will ensure that, once you become a counsellor, you are providing the best possible service to those who need it. Please note these courses are to develop your skills to train and work as a counsellor. They are not intended to provide personal counselling.

We offer part-time courses from Level 1 to Level 3.

EARLY YEARS CHILDCARE

These courses help you build the knowledge and skills needed when working with children in pre-school settings.

These skills are also applicable to a diverse range of job roles in children and young people's workforce settings. You will learn about the value of play, child development, partnership with parents and building positive relationships with children. Courses available include tasters, courses with guaranteed job interviews, level 1, level 2 and level 3 qualifications.

If you enrol on a level 2 course, you will need to have a placement in a childcare setting for ideally ten but a minimum of six hours per week.

Level 3 courses are intended for those currently working in the sector. We will require a letter from your manager to confirm you will be able to undertake certain duties and tasks to provide evidence of work-based competence for your portfolio.

HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE



The Health and Social care sector is growing fast with a need for many more staff to care for those in our society who are unwell or vulnerable.

These courses are for those who wish to pursue a career in this sector and learn about how to provide a high standard of support to a wide variety of people in a range of care settings and how to reduce the risks of malpractice and negligence. We offer part-time courses from Level 1 to Level 3.

Learners on the Level 3 course will need to be working in the sector as you will need to show competence in both knowledge and skills.

TEACHER TRAINING



Interested in teaching or training? This part-time course provides you with the skills, knowledge and understanding of the post 16 teaching profession.

Teaching in adult education is "family friendly" - courses run in term time, start and finish times allow for school runs. You don't need a degree and can qualify in a matter of months studying part time. Many people work as a tutor alongside other jobs to boost their income and share their knowledge and skills

It will give you an insight into the roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training. It will show you how to plan and deliver teaching sessions, how to assess and give constructive feedback to your learners. Many learning providers will recruit you if you have this award whilst you work towards your full teaching qualification.

WORKING IN SCHOOLS

These courses provide you with an understanding of the knowledge required to work directly with children and young people in a school or college environment.

You will learn about children and young people's development, how to support children and young people's positive behaviour and communication, and how to support children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND).

We offer part-time courses from Level 1 to Level 3. For the Level 2 Diploma you will need a placement in a school for ideally ten but a minimum of six hours per week.

The level 3 course is intended for those currently employed in the sector. We will require confirmation from your manager that you will be able to undertake certain duties and tasks to provide evidence of work-based competence for your portfolio.

SEND DYSLEXIA, DYSPRAXIA, MENTAL HEALTH



This suite of short, part-time courses will give you the opportunity to apply new knowledge and skills to improve access to learning for children with Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND).

While specifically useful for teaching and learning support staff, these courses would also be suitable for parents, carers and guardians of children with SEND to gain a better understanding of strategies to improve support. Courses include ADHD, Asperger's, dyslexia and understanding children's mental health.

Our level 1 and 2 courses may be free (subject to eligibility).

FOOD SAFETY FOR CATERING LEVEL 2



This qualification is aimed at individuals who are, or intend to be, food handlers working in catering.

The short six hour course helps to prepare you for employment in catering role, or to support a role in the workplace. Learners gaining this qualification will know that food safety is the responsibility of everyone involved in the storage, preparation, cooking service and handling of food. You will be required to take a multiple-choice exam at the end of the course.



EMERGENCY FIRST AID AT WORK

This six hour course will provide you with a certificate in Emergency First Aid at Work level 3

This will be awarded by tutor observations and assessments throughout the course. You will learn how to carry out primary and secondary surveys, deal with choking, fits, allergic reactions, cardiac arrest, CPR, and use of a defibrillator.

PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID



This course is offered to employers for staff continued professional development (CPD) or to community groups.

You will gain a certificate in Paediatric First Aid level 3. This will be awarded by tutor observations and assessments throughout the course. You will learn how to carry out primary and secondary surveys, deal with choking, fits, allergic reactions, cardiac arrest, CPR, and use of a defibrillator. You will also learn about other common childhood illnesses.








FOREIGN LANGUAGES
